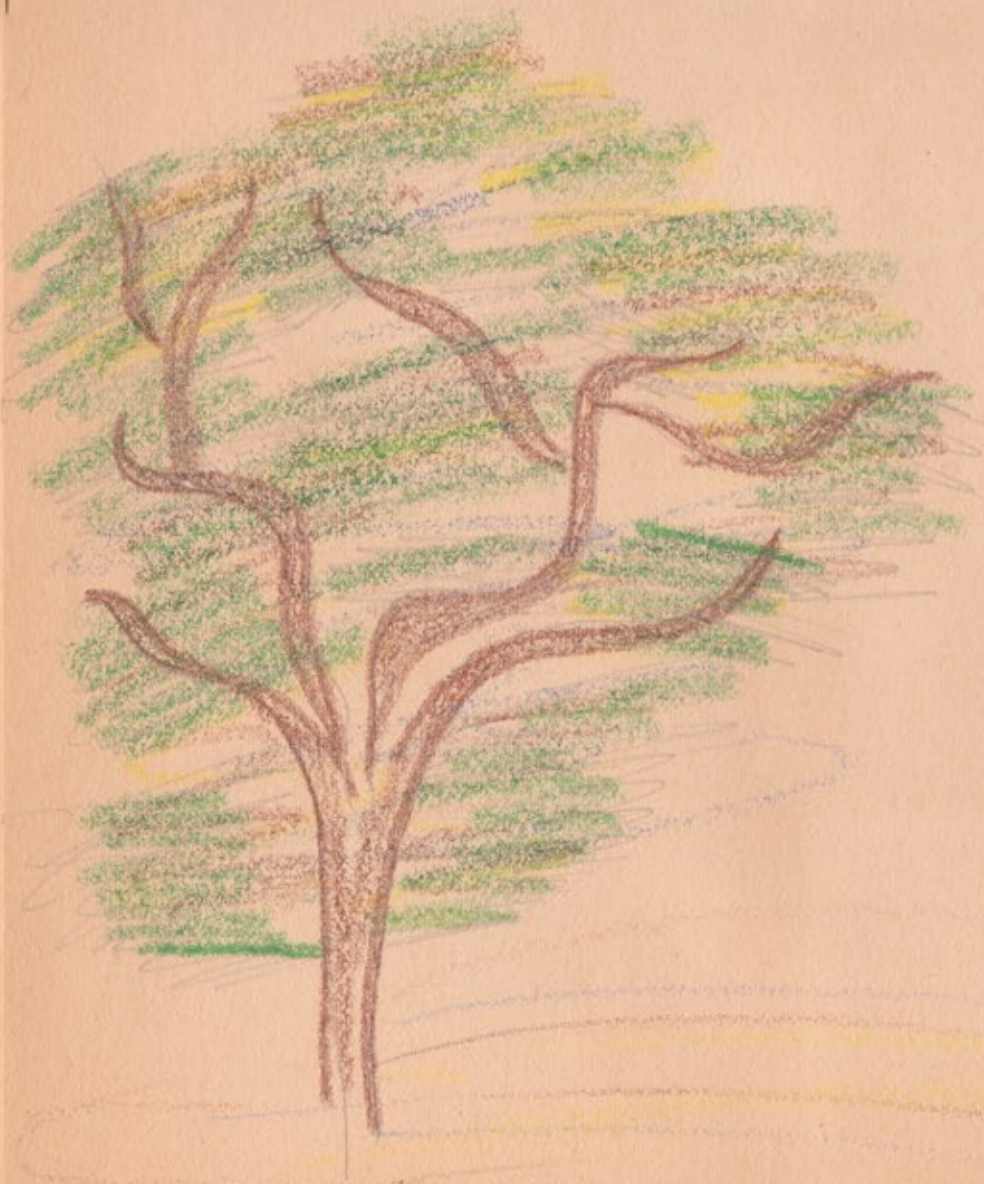

Girls Staters Pick Office Candidates

Two Highland High School girls, Ruth Ballenger and Lorraine Pittard were named candidates for Girls State governor after primary elections held on the University of New Mexico campus Tuesday night.

Ruth will be a candidate of the mythical "Federalist" party and Lorraine will carry the "Nationalist" banner into the general election Thursday.

A run-off election was held to determine lieutenant governor candidates for each party.
