Title of Bill: Public Collegiate Library Act

.0 An Act

Relating to college students in good standing with a public or private university, in which a state funded library is available to students to check out books for a single academic year or semester. Whereas students will be charged triple the manufacturer's price of any book that fails to be returned or is returned damaged at the finish of the term; whereas the implementation of this act will reduce student debt; whereas a tax will be taken from the cost of tuition of any secondary-educational institute to fund this library.

Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 2016 that:

- .8 A state funded collegiate library be available to individuals in good standing with their university.
- 19 **Section I. Short Title. –** This act may be cited as the "Collegiate Library Act"
- 20 **Section II. Definitions.** As used in the "Collegiate Library Act"
- A. "Check out" being the act of borrowing a book pertaining to a college course free of charge for the duration of a course.
- 23 **Section III. Provisions.** This Program would be monitored by the New Mexico Higher Education

- 19 New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are hereby repealed.
- Section V. Enactment. This bill shall go into effect 1 year after passage.
