Be It Enacted By The American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State 201	6
Section I. Body: Relating to the cleanup of dangerous mining sites funded by	
the ongoing mining industry. Whereas mining in New Mexico causes airborne	
illness and groundwater-related illness; whereas New Mexico waters are suffering; whereas funds are necessary for cleanup of abandoned mining sites; whereas a percentage of revenue from mineral sources in New Mexico will fund this cleanup.	
Section II Definitions: "Mineral courses" include and patroloum natural	
Section II. Definitions: "Mineral sources" include coal, petroleum, natural gas, gold, silver, copper, lead, molybdenum, and zinc.	
Section III. Penalty: The New Mexico Mining industry must offer partial income to contribute to the cleanup of previous mining sources.	
Section IV. Repeal: All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in	
the Constitution of the State of New Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are herby repealed.	
Section V. Effective Date: This act shall become effective immediately upon	
its passage and approval by the American Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls	
State Governor or its otherwise becoming a law.
