8	RELATING TO PROVIDING PLASTIC STRAWS IN RESTAURANTS			
9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY NEW			
10	MEXICO GIRLS STATE:			
11	SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS			
12	SECTION 2. PROVITIONS This bill would prohibit a restaurant from providing single-			
13	use plastic straws to customers unless requested by the customer. Providing single-use			
14	plastic straws to a customer unless requested by the customer would be punished by a fine			
15	of not more than 300\$. This bill will serve as a deterrent for restaurants			

- ordering plastic straws in the first place. Even plastic Straws that do get recycled often don't
- 2 make it through the mechanical recycling sorter because they are so small and lightweight.
- 3 Therefore they contaminate recycling loads or get disposed of as garbage. It is estimated
- 4 that the average person uses 1.6 plastic-straws per day. That means that if 25,000
- 5 residents stop using plastic-straws, we would eliminate 5,000,000 plastic-straws and
- 6 prevent them from entering oceans and harming wildlife. Plastic straws don't decompose,
- 7 or biodegrade. Plastics can stay in landfills for hundreds of years, and plastic in the ocean
- 8 called micro-plastics can poison animals and substantially harm the ocean's ecosystem.
- 9 Microplastics are particularly problematic because, as the life cycle comes full circle, they
- bring adverse impacts for humans too. We ingest the fish that have ingested such plastic,
- and it is no easier for us to digest plastic then it is for the sea life to digest plastic. Tens of
- thousands of whales, birds, seals and turtles are killed every year from plastic litter in the
- marine environment as plastic cannot be digested or passed by an animal. Each day in the
- 14 United States of America plastic straws create enough waste to wrap the circumference of
- the earth 2.5 times.
- 16 SECTION 3. PENALTY. Providing single-use plastic straws to customers unless
- requested by the customer shall be punished by a fine of not more than 300\$.
- 18 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. -
- All laws, acts, provisions, or parts of laws contained in the Constitution of the State of New
- 20 Mexico in conflict with any provision of this act are herby repealed.
- 22 This act shall become effective 90 days after it's passage and approval by the American
- 23 Legion Auxiliary New Mexico Girls State Governor or it's otherwise becoming a law.
